COMMISSIONS BY TARAL WAYNE

* PICK THE OPTION THAT IS RIGHT FOR YOU *

1. BLACK AND WHITE ORIGINALS

An inked drawing in one of three degrees of complexity. The price for a more complicated background or additional figures can be negotiated.

Option A: 8 1/2 by 11

Option B: 8 1/2 by 11

Option C: 11 by 17



(Basic single character)



(Opt. A, plus detail)



(Bigger/more characters/detail)

Option A: \$75 B: \$100 C: \$175

2. COLOURING OLD B&W ART

Choose any B&W piece of art that I've already drawn, and suggest how you want a photocopy of it coloured.

Option A: \$75 B: \$100 C: \$175

3. COLOURING NEW B&W ART

If, on the other hand, you want a completely new drawing colored, you have to get the B&W original drawn and then a copy of it colored. To own both B&W and color versions, add 1 and 2 from above.

Option A: \$75 B: \$125 C: \$225

4. CUSTOM PENCIL SKETCHES

A finished sketch drawn to your specifications. The subject can be anything within reason. If you have something very specific in mind, it helps to supply references.

Option A: \$20 B: \$30 C: \$50

5. COLOUR PRINTS

Fine quality Canon or Xerox color photocopier prints. (B&W sample on request of each, for \$1 each.)

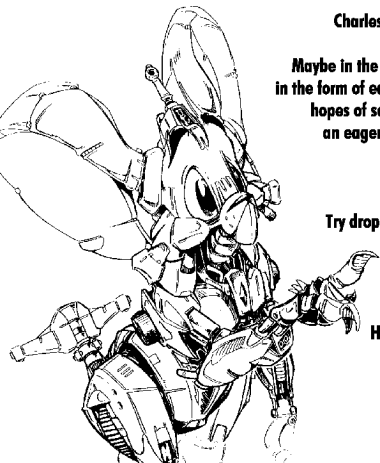

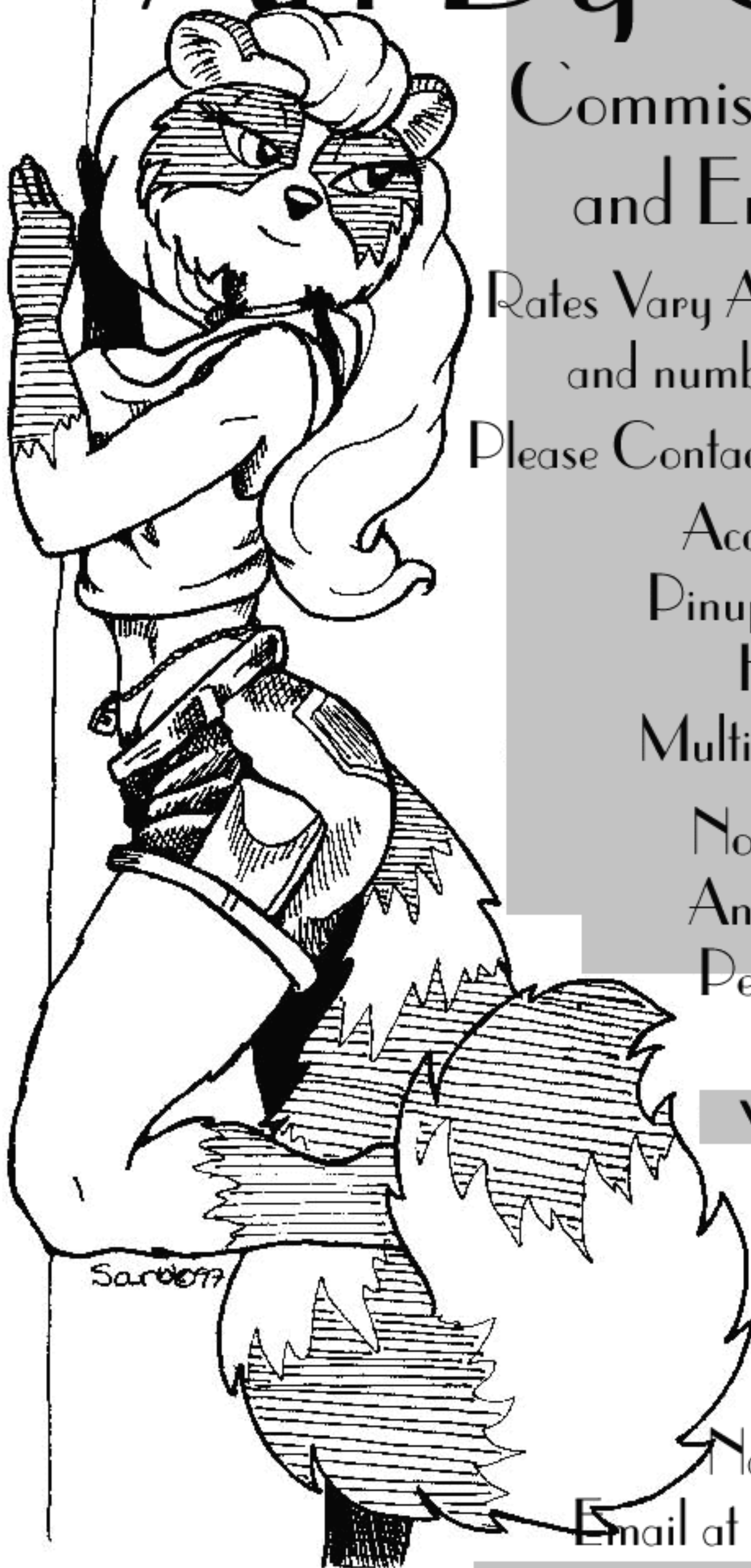

Then again, how many disgruntled postal workers have their own armored car?

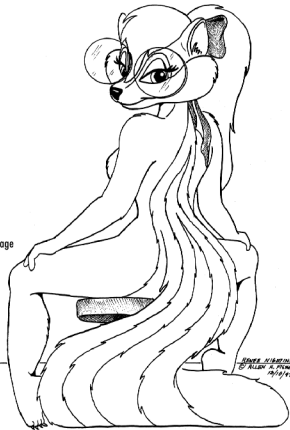
His characters here are on temporary leave from both their senses AND their traditional stomping grounds, which can be found in MAYHEM COUNTY.

Commission Guidelines (private & commercial):

*Base price for a single character, inked illustration is \$15. Up to two additional characters can be added to the base piece for an additional \$10 and \$12 respectively. Adult themed illustrations begin at \$18.

*Illustrations with high detail carry an additional \$12 to the base price. This will be left up to the artist.

*Background inclusion in the piece is left up to the artist. As a rule, they are not. Background, if used, will incur an additional \$15.

*Adult themes NOT acceptable include necrophilia, pedophilia, snuff, and helium.

*Adult themed commissions WILL require an age statement.

*Female characters are preferred to males.

*Please write in about what you would like illustrated. Do not send money on the outset. This will give the artist a chance to see if it can be rendered as well as set the price.

*Be as specific as possible with your request so as to avoid an illustration you do not like. Otherwise, a general theme is fine, using artist leeway.

*Rough pencils may be sent out to the commissioner before final inking for comment.

*One commission at a time, please.

*Payment must be made up front before work begins.

*Originals will be retained by the artist. The commissioner may choose either a 8.5X11 print or the full size 11X17 print.

*All artwork is mailed flat and shipped via either Airborne Express or Priority/Certified USPS.

*Work time on the commission varies depending on the schedule. An estimate will be given at the time of sale.

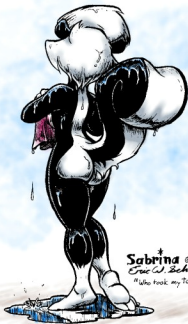
