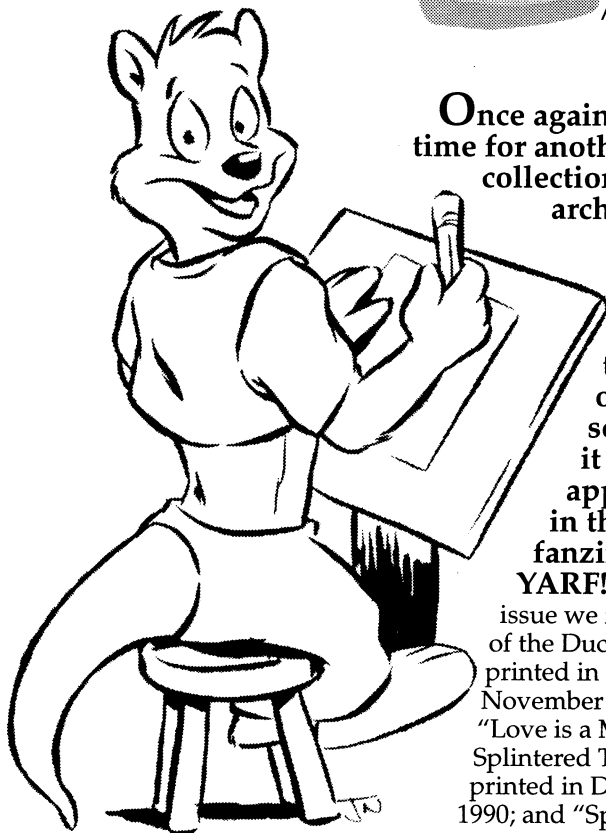

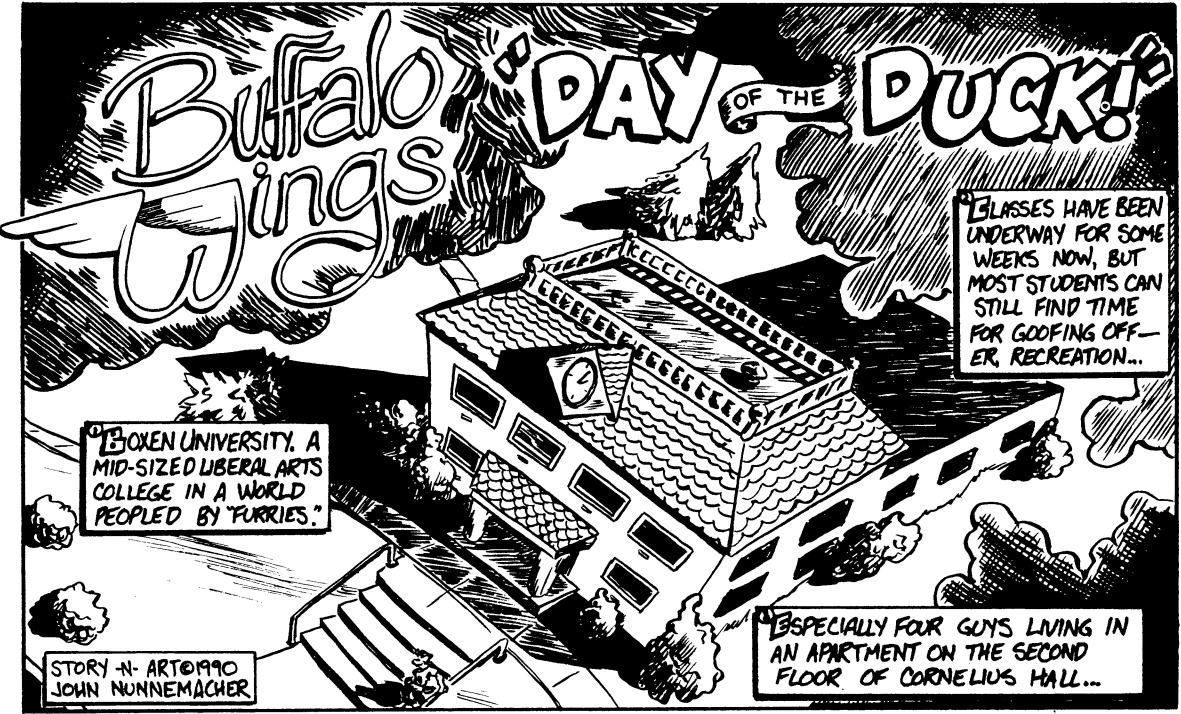
Here are a few notes on

Boxen University

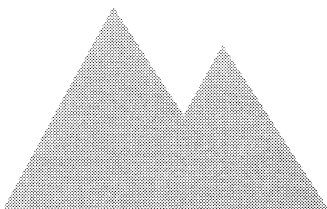
