Voting With Your Dollars -- A Word from the Publisher

As we enter 1994 it is customary to look back at the last year to see where we have come from and where we are going. I guess the Antarctic Press is no different in this time of reflection. The year of 1993 has seen tremendous growth in our company. We added a computer art division, moved into a 3000-square-foot office and hired new staff employees (production, editorial, and translations). We've also quadrupled our comic output in just a year. But while there is occasion to celebrate, it may be too premature. For the most part, sales have remained low (but consistent and improving) but we are still ignored, in general, by the fan press (except for the Comics Buyer's Guide and Comic Shop News).

While sitting in my office, it occurred to me that AP is now entering into its ninth year of publishing comics and a lot has happened since we first published MANGAZINE back in 1985. A lot of comic companies have come and gone in that time, victims of whatever forces conspired to do them in. I'd like to think that AP would be immune to such forces, but I would only be fooling myself.

Will AP survive another nine years? That depends on you, our readers. By buying an AP book you are voting with your dollars. You are sending a message to your retailer that you will support his or her store as long

as they carry the books you want. I am not going to get into yet another small publisher's diatribe about how the market is treating us unfairly, or how you should buy our books because they're like Marvel's, or Image's, or Valiant's, etc., or how they'll go up in value, or how different we are, or how everybody else sucks except us. No, I feel that what we do speaks for itself. If you like our books you will “vote” with your dollars. If you do not, then you won't.

So let's look back and see what AP has done for the past nine years; here's a list of the top 50 books we've published:
