Dear Penguins,

Another step on the road to becoming #1 Antarctic anthropomorphic letterhack (anyone can be a big frog by defining a small enough pond).

Furrlough #17: Interesting cover. I wonder what's going on? Even after I noticed the title, I wasn't any wiser; been a long time since I read Dune. "Here Comes a Candle" is off to a rousing start, with fine drawing, a good Elizabethan milieu, and a big, interesting cast. The fairy-tale beginning is perfect, the frontispiece beautiful. Lots of good jokes, like the table of the elements on p.6. The story is just silly enough that the argument over who is to be the narrator is not intrusive. (Selfreference can be deadly if not kept in line.) "The Sound and the Furry" - see above, except that I also want to compliment Eric Oppen on getting the German in this episode mostly correct as well as funny. I hope that even monolinguals can understand "licht auf das Ende des Tunnel sehen". (That's "am Ende des Tunnels".) "Samurai Mice" is a deliciously funny dessert. And after that, another intelligent and enlightening letter column. I feel stupid not having seen the "penal Australia" connection of "Watering Hole" until Jason Gaffney pointed it

Aztec Anthropomorphic Amazons #1: This was lots of fun; even the foreword was great. Kurt may be a little too apologetic about the title; after all, at least the cover is definitely Aztec. I would have liked to see the Shon Howell illo that inspired the book. All parts are good, but "Lights Out" is my favorite; funny nitwits, beautiful inks.

Tank Vixens #2: This issue devotes less time to satirizing furversion and more to satisfying it, but it's still fun: the proverbial dropped soap and the echo of Shanda on p.4, the explanation of why SF soldiers are such bad shots, the dangers of nostalgia, the cameo by the droids, and especially Anastasia's bio. Good love scene; the dirty talk was less strained than last issue. This is one series I don't want to see more of, though; I don't think the joke would wear well. (Say, what does Paul Kidd think "I'chayim" means? It's not a German greeting, it's a Yiddish/Hebrew toast.)

Furrlough #18 is an excellent issue. A good episode of "Stosstrupp", notably the first page. My sympathies are with Karl. The best thing in the issue is the beautifully drawn and written "Here Comes a Candle", with an even more

gorgeous splash panel than last time, a fine (and growing) cast of characters, and the first signs of how the title will become relevant. And "Girls Night Out" is a fine finish; beautifully done faces, funny cameo from Gold Digger, great last two pages. The best "Collars and Cuffs" yet.

Star Jacks #1 didn't do much for me, I'm afraid. It's decently drawn and adequately scripted, but no more, so details can spoil my pleasure. Scott's abominable attempt at a French accent me fait chier, and a couple of the women on the cover have such severe cases of alstonitis that it's hard to believe they can remain upright. The bodies are better inside, but the faces aren't so hot.

Furrlough #19: A big guns cover, eh. But the story behind it is not bad at all. It has a Varcel's Vixens feel to it - bad girls in space - though it's in no way an imitation. The art is a little hard to follow at times but the storytelling is good. "Here Comes a Candle" has everything that made the first two installments so good except a splash panel, and I wonder if one was somehow lost. The story picks up with Nedwin already started on a journey of which there was hardly even a foreshadowing last time.

Hit the Beach 1994: I don't think this one is up to the 1993 edition, but it was still well worthwhile. It would have been hard to top the 1993 cover, but this one is quite attractive and interesting. Inside there are too many pinups for my taste, but many of the one-pagers have too much substance to just be called 'pinups'. That's a wonderful volleyball game in Pat Kelley's p.2, for example, and the tar oil is good too. What's that knife for? Rosales is excellent as always, beautiful and historically believable. And the Northern folks, Rovainen and Arnorsson, are snazzy and funny. Among the pure pinups I'd say my favorites are the Shanda section and the Nakagawas. "Beach and Moan" is a great confrontation done by two of the best Antarctic storytellers, the no-question top of the

It does not matter if it shows modern tanks or futuristic space craft, please send an updated shopping list, because every time I read or look at pinups of other artist's work, (for example: Furrlough #3, p.1, Briano's art; p.32, Joe Rosales's art; #4, p.2, Shon's art; p.29, Jerry Collins's art) I go absolutely crazy, insane, and fall in love with how they're drawn, and it just makes me turn into a howling, crazed but kind, lovable werewolf.


