













































YOU'RE NOT GOING TO BELIEVE THIS ...

What better for a B&W comic than penguins, and what better penguins than these! It's refreshing to find a funny animal book where the animals look and act like they are supposed to (well... almost). There is a definite trend to take any theme and make the characters animals as if that somehow makes the comic funny and obviates any need to write well or draw convincingly. Samurai Penguin scores on both these points. These penguins look an behave in a way that sees just how real penguins should behave, and they are very amusing

with it. However it is the art which brings the whole comic to a high point - strikingly stylised b&w cartooning with strong pleasing use of zipatone and effective heavy panel borders, a feeling of Sienkiewicz simplification and distortion overlying the cartoon nature of the comic. and a nice flowing balance of humour and realism ( and if that all sounds a bit pseud, well I'm really impressed with the comic, so there.)

I hope the comic succeeds as it is refreshingly different.
